DHANGYAN: FINANCIAL LITERACY PROGRAM

We are pleased to bring to schools for the first-time, a financial literacy program. Being conducted for students of Std. 8, the program will cover various financial subjects such as smart goals, budgeting, insurance, investing and banking. Aimed to empower youth, we are keen to educate young students about a very important life skill - that of financial literacy.

The program is offered free for USO member schools. Schools should register by filling a short form. Details and sign-up link shall be shared with the school for passing on to the students who wish to sign up for the program. Each student would then have to study the first 5 modules of DhanGyan material. The material is very interactive and easy to understand. It also has regular knowledge checks to ensure that the students are following the various concepts presented.

What is DhanGyan?

DhanGyan is an award-winning financial literacy program, aimed to empower youth by improving understanding of financial resources, including savings, investing and budgeting for an overall sense of financial well-being.

As part of the program, we shall also be conducting awareness sessions led by officials from Tata Capital to speak about the significance of each of these concepts. Over the 4 days, students and teachers can join us, hear from experts, ask questions, and also hear real life experiences.

The program finishes off with an online test for participating students that shall test their knowledge of what they learnt. Successful students shall be given e-Certificates (with scores 35%-89%); Certificate and Medal (scores 90%-99%) and Certificate and trophy (scores of 100%).

School with greater than 50 student sign-ups shall receive a Commemorative Plaque, and teachers and principals shall get Certificate of Appreciation and goodies. For details: usoindia.org
